coarse hair rated Acrylic/Oil. <u>TWO CANVAS</u> (painting surface) 2 choices: (personal preference) Stretched on a flat panel OR stretched over a wood frame <u>TWO WATER CONTAINERS</u> for rinsing brushes, one for dirty water rinsing, one for clean water dipping. Must have a wide mouth and be at least 2 quarts. Small buckets, cool whip containers Ice cream pails (1 ¼ gallon) are my favorite. They don't tip over, have handles, therefore, are easy to carry.

**PALETTE KNIFE;** Personal preference, many different shapes. A cheap plastic set is good; it will give you a chance to try different ones.

A student brand of paint is fine if you are a beginner; Liquitex Basics, for example. Paint is priced by ratio of pigment to filler.
