

Art Teacher for GAAC After School Art K-4 Program

The Glen Arbor Arts Center [GAAC] seeks an experienced, dynamic Art Teacher /Arts Educator for its 2021-2022 After School Art program. There are four sessions:

Session 1: Oct 19-Nov 16

Session 2: Nov 30-Jan 11 (no classes Dec 21 or 28)

Session 3: Jan 25-Feb 22

Session 4: March 8 - April 19 (no classes March 29 or April 5)

Preference is to have the same instructor for all sessions, but we can be flexible for the right candidate(s).

Responsibilities:

The Art Teacher is responsible for developing and teaching art classes for children in grades K - 4 on Tuesdays from 3:30-6 pm (class runs 4 - 5:30 pm). The Art Teacher responsibilities include:

- Planning class sequence and structure and working closely with the Education Manager to plan quality, process-oriented art projects in drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture, and more. The classes focus on technique, exposure to different media, and exploring the creative process in a fun, supportive environment.
- Studio preparation, materials management, set up and clean up.
- Communication with parents of children enrolled in the program.
- Works in five-week blocks, from 3:30-6 pm on Tuesdays.

Qualifications

- Two or more years of successful experience working with elementary-age children in an art setting.
- An understanding of the developmental needs of children, including learning styles, age-appropriateness of curriculum, and positive classroom management.
- Bachelors' degree in Arts Education or a BFA preferred.

Compensation

The Art Teacher position pays \$500 per five-class session.
