IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Check in at the Glen Arbor Township Hall between 7:30 am-9:30 am.
- Event proceeds regardless of weather.
- To paint in the National Lakeshore, you need a park pass, which can be purchased at nearby D.H. Day Campground, at the park headquarters in Empire, or at the self-service kiosk at the Maritime Museum west of Glen Haven.

TURNING IN WORK

RETURN YOUR EXHIBIT—READY FINISHED PAINTINGS TO GLEN ARBOR TOWNSHIP HALL BEFORE 4:00 pm. Artwork MUST be on display by 4:00 pm to be judged. No exceptions.

- You may enter up to TWO paintings, suitable for display. Paintings MAY NOT EXCEED 28" (unframed) in any direction. Finished edge or framed work is required for this event, simple frames are best.
- Work tables will be available for your use for matting/ framing or edge finishing.
- If you are painting multiple images in a single frame, each image must be date stamped.
- Upon return, artists will receive a box lunch.
- Early Preview and Purchase is at 5:00 pm for Curator Circle, Donors and artists.

EVENING SALE

- First, second, third, and two honorable mention monetary prizes awarded.
- Pick up any unsold work at the close of the sale at 7:00 pm.
 The Township Hall will be closed on Sunday. GAAC is not responsible for any work left.
- Checks for sales will be sent out within ten days; 60% of price to artist/40% to benefit GAAC.
 If you sell your work as you are painting or after the close of the event, we ask that you notify GAAC and honor this 40-60% split.
