



2026 ARTIST INFORMATION: QUICK DRAW FAQ

Event

- Preregistration: \$25 members/ \$30 nonmembers. Registration at the door: \$30.
- Registration takes place at the Glen Arbor Town Hall from 8:30-11 AM Friday of the event.
- Due to our limited exhibition space, we cannot accommodate everyone therefore you must be at least 18 years old to register.
- All submitted art will need to have a visible “date stamp”, bring your canvas or paper with you to registration and we will stamp and date.

Artwork

- Any 2-D media is accepted.
- You are on “your honor” to paint no longer than 3 hours total time. You may submit two paintings; however, the total painting time is still only 3 hours.
- This year our boundary area is Glen Haven to the Coast Guard Station.
- Maximum paint surface is 24” in any direction.
- Frames are optional (although recommended), edges should be finished, and paper should be matted.
- We theme our Quick Draw or use “boundaries” because we believe this allows for a more diverse collection of paintings as everyone interprets the theme or area differently. It also places artists in the same area and helps build excitement for the sale.

Entry

- Artwork can be returned to the Town Hall on **Friday afternoon from noon – 3 PM.**
- Artwork must be on display by **3 PM** to be judged.
- Artists should photograph their work before the sale.
- Accepted paintings should have a minimum price of \$150.
- Artwork **NOT FOR SALE** will not be displayed for the sale.

Sale

- Quick Draw paintings will be displayed alongside Sunsetter paintings at the Friday evening sale from 4-6:30 pm.
- Sales commission is 60% to the artist/ 40% to GAAC. Commission checks are mailed within 10 business days.
- Unsold art needs to be picked up by 6:30 PM. GAAC is not responsible for any unsold and unpicked up art.

General Information

- Please be aware of our Conflict-of-Interest policy located on our website.
- A permit is required to paint in the National Lakeshore.
- GAAC Artists Membership is \$65 per year.
- Canvases must be date stamped for each event.
- Bring your canvas or painting surface with you when you register and we will stamp!
- Restrooms are located at Glen Arbor Garden, Glen Arbor Park, Empire Park, the National Lakeshore Headquarters in Empire, and the Glen Arbor Town Hall.
