



## 2026 ARTIST INFORMATION: SUNSETTER FAQ

### Event

- No pre-registration. Event is weather dependent and will be cancelled if it rains.
- Registration is open to the first 50 artists to register at the Town Hall on the Thursday before the event, from 6-7:30 PM. Registration fee is \$30.
- You must be at least 18 years old to register, as the event is limited to 50 artists.
- All submitted art will need to have a visible “date stamp”, bring your canvas or paper with you to registration and we will stamp and date.

### Artwork

- Any 2-D media is accepted.
- Maximum paint surface is 24” in any direction.
- Frames are optional (although recommended), edges should be finished, and paper should be matted.
- There are no painting boundaries. Capture the sunset where you wish.

### Entry

- Artwork can be returned to the Town Hall on **Friday morning from 8:30 – 11 AM**.
- Artwork must be on display by **11:30 Friday morning** to be judged.
- Artists should photograph their work before the sale.
- Accepted paintings should have a minimum price of \$150.
- Artwork **NOT FOR SALE** will not be displayed for the sale.

### Sale

- Sunsetter paintings will be displayed alongside the Quick Draw paintings at the Friday evening sale from 4-6:30 PM.
- Sales commission is 60% to the artist/ 40% to GAAC. Commission checks are mailed within 10 business days.
- Unsold art needs to be picked up by 6:30 PM. GAAC is not responsible for any unsold and unpicked up art.

**General Information**

- Please be aware of our Conflict of Interest policy located on our website.
- A permit is required to paint in the National Lakeshore.
- GAAC Artists Membership is \$65 per year.
- Canvases must be date stamped for each event.
- Bring your canvas or painting surface with you when you register and we will stamp!
- Restrooms are located at Glen Arbor Garden, Glen Arbor Park, Empire Park, the National Lakeshore Headquarters in Empire, and the Glen Arbor Town Hall.
